Format: In all events third place will be fenced for, no ties.

Medals will be awarded to the top 3 places in each event.

U-19 Events: If there are only 2 fencers, one 15 touch bout will be fenced to determine 1st place. For 3 or more fencers, one round of pools will be fenced, 100% promoted to a Direct Elimination table.

Div I-A Events: If there are 10 or fewer fencers, one round of pools will determine the order of place. For 11 or more fencers, one round of pools will be fenced, 100% promoted to a Direct Elimination table.

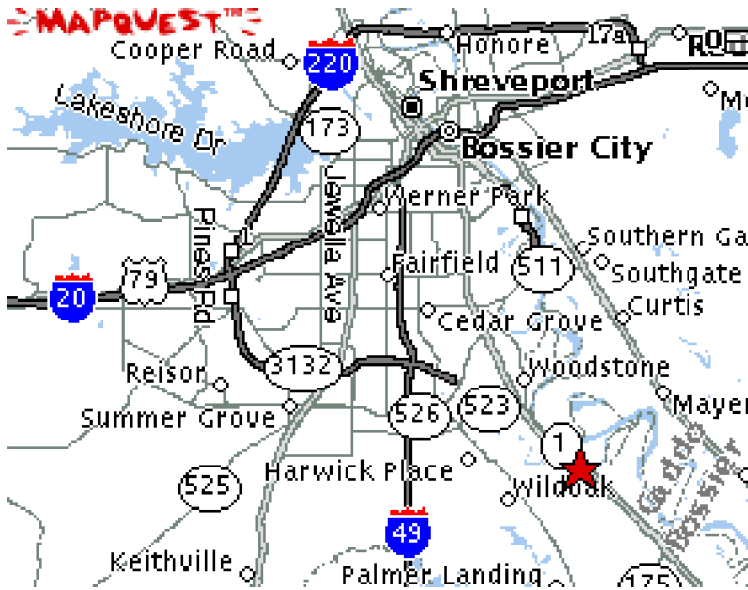
Eligibility: Requirements are given the Operations Manual in Chapter III, Section 1. A. (1)-(2).

Junior fencers will need the signature of a parent or guardian (not a coach).

Membership: To join the USFA, fencers will need to provide their social security number. Payment for memberships is made directly to the USFA.

Participants are required to fence in proper attire; USFA rules will be adhered to.

There are no alternate qualifiers to any National tournaments.



Venue: One University Place

Directions: From the east or west: from I-20 go south on I-49. Take exit #201 onto LA3132 East. Keep left at the fork in the ramp. Merge into LA3132. Turn left at the light at Burt Kouns Industrial Loop. Turn Right on Hwy 1 South. Turn left into the campus of LSU at the main entrance and follow the signs. From the south: From I-49 take exit 199 to the right on to Burt Kouns Industrial Loop. Turn Right on Hwy 1 South. Turn left into the campus of LSU at the main entrance and follow the signs. From the north: Follow Hwy 1/71 south. Stay on Hwy 1 until you get to the main entrance of the LSU campus. Turn left into the campus and follow the signs.
